| Dragon Dictation | Dragon Dictation is a voice recognition application designed for an iPhone or iPad that allows you to easily speak and instantly see your text or email messages. |
| Evernote | Evernote is an app that helps with organization and can permit you to voice-record notes. |
| OverDrive | OverDrive Media Console is an app that provides access to audio-books and e-books from public and school libraries in various digital formats. |
